When leading health care was only accessible to the wealthy, Houston gave birth to what would become the world's largest and finest medical district, The Texas Medical Center.





Imagine Houston has the distinct honor of depicting this wonderful city through the beauty of photography. This book is a loving tribute to the people of the city we all call home.


